The Principal Investigator covers the time used for data administration and transfer of data (min 10 hours following SDS current prize per hour).

The project leader (Merete Osler) approves all manuscript from subprojects before they are submitted (in order to ensure that the above formalities are kept).

The subproject leader is responsible for the steering group receiving reprints of all publications, resulting from their work.
